

The story behind MSAP

It all started in 2011 when MindClick created the Hospitality Sustainable Purchasing Consortium (HSPC) to solve the complexity around sustainability.

Joined by Marriott International, the U.S. Green Building Council, 20 FF&E vendors, design firms, and purchasing companies, the members of the HSPC created a framework to measure the social and environmental impacts of vendors and their products.

From this framework, MSAP was born.

MindClick assigns a score out of a possible 200 points based on 9 key metrics. 3rd party audits, certifications and eco-labels provide the proof points.








MSAP ratings
